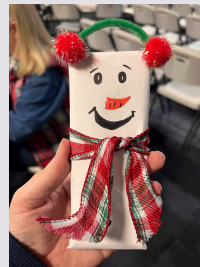

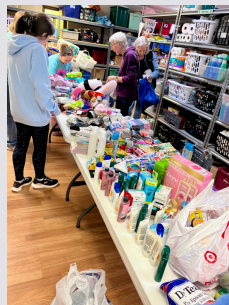
Christmas Movie Night

Broccoli Casserole

Ingredients

- 2 (10 oz) packages frozen chopped broccoli (cooked and drained)
- 1 (10 3/4 oz) can cream of mushroom soup (condensed)
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 eggs (lightly beaten)
- 1 medium onion (chopped)
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 cup sharp cheddar cheese (grated)
- 1/2 stick butter (melted)
- 1/2 pkg. Pepperidge Farm Herb Seasoned Stuffing

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350°F and spray a 13x9 inch baking dish with cooking spray.
 2. In a large bowl, combine broccoli, mayo, cheese, soup, and eggs; mix well.
 3. Pour mixture into the baking dish, top with crushed crackers, and drizzle melted butter over the crackers.
- Bake for 35 minutes or until set and browned.

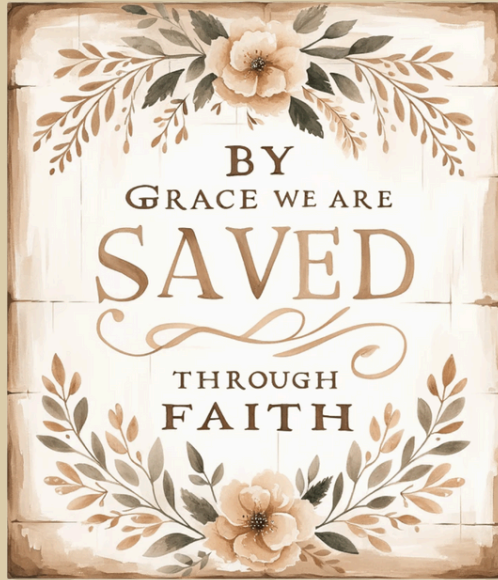
Easter: Behold Your King



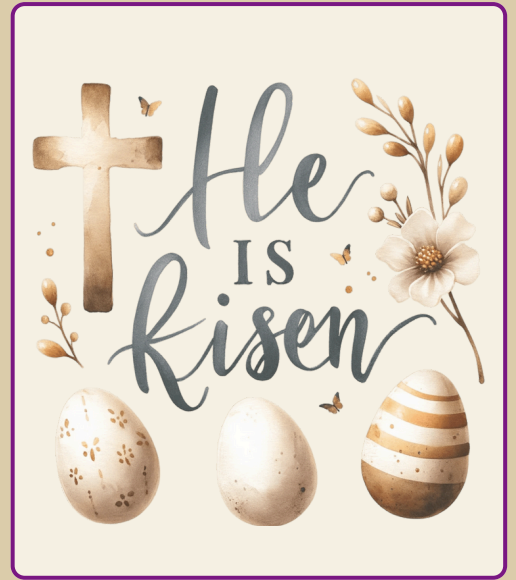
